Sh. Suresh Arora, IPS (Retd) Chief Information Commissioner, Punjab was the Chief Guest & Director Health Services presides over

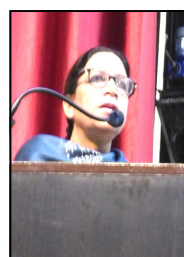

1415 persons imparted First Aid Training

The First Aid Training is imparted by the Punjab State Red Cross Branch. It is a 16 hours training which is completed minimum in 8 days duration. During the quarter, Punjab State Red Cross Branch imparted First Aid Training to 1415 trainees of various departments/organizations which included 394 can-

didates from M/s Moolson Coors, Bhankarpur, Mohali, M/s Jai Bhawani Industry, Nalagarh, Baddi (Solan), M/s IPF Vikram Ltd. Kurali, Chd University, Bhakhra Beas Management, Vibracouscie, Indian Pvt. Ltd. Ind. Area, Mohalla and made a collection of Rs.9,66,300/- as training fee.

Relief material to Maharashtra Flood Victims

A request was received from the Indian Red Cross Society, Maharashtra State Branch for providing relief material to help the flood victims of Maharashtra State. The Punjab State Red Cross Branch has sent monetary support of Rs.2 Lakhs to Maharashtra State Branch on account of relief to the flood victims.

1110 Blood units collected through 12 camps



To boost up the voluntary blood donation movement, the State

Red Cross Branch organized 12 blood donation camps. These camps were organized with the support and cooperation of other local NGOs. During the quarter, we have collected total 1110 units of blood.

Punjab Red Cross in Service of pilgrims of Mata Chintpurni Mela

Mata Chintpurni Mela is celebrated in the month of August in Navratras every year where thousands of pilgrims reach to pay their obeisance. For this purpose, the pilgrims from various districts of Punjab, first reach District Hoshiarpur. There is great rush on the way from district Hoshiarpur to Mata Chintpurni. Sometimes the pilgrims got injured as they come barefoot to fulfill their wish with the blessings of Mata Chintpurni. To help and serve these pilgrims, Punjab State Red Cross Branch along-with District Administration & District Red Cross Branch, Hoshiarpur, came forward. 3 First aid posts were setup on the way to Mata Chintpurni temple and ambulances were also made available for the wounded or sick pilgrims. Teachers and student volunteers from G.G.S.S.S, Railway Mandi, Hoshiarpur, G.S.S.S., Khuaspur Hiran and G.S.S.S., Chohal, Hoshiarpur were deputed to provide their services at these First Aid Posts. During this camp, thousands of pilgrims were provided First Aid services and free medicines by the Red Cross volunteers and several lives were saved through ambulance services.

Services through Ambulance & Funeral Vans

Punjab State Red Cross Branch is providing 24*7 hours services through ambulance vans and funeral vans at very subsidized rates. We have a fleet of 7 (seven) Ambulances (AC as well as Non AC) and 3 funeral vans. Each Ambulance van is provided with First Aid Box & First Aid Trained driver. From July to Sept 2019, the total number of beneficiaries were 248 The number of beneficiaries of funeral vans during the quarter were 139.

Screening Committee meetings held at Punjab Red Cross Bhawan, Chandigarh to implement the MOUs

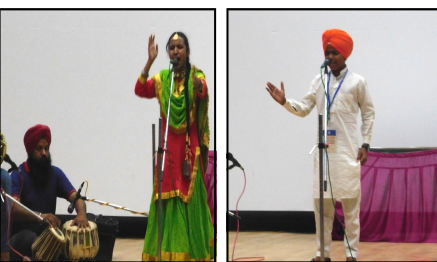

Activities Reports of Projects

Psychosocial support to 528 persons living with HIV/AIDS

The care & support centre is working at Saket Hospital, Patiala by the Punjab State Red Cross Branch, Chandigarh. This project is being sponsored by Hindustan Latex Family Planning Promotion Trust, Noida. Sarbat Da Bhala, Charitable Trust is providing their assistance in holding monthly camps for PLHIV. More than 360 clients were benefitted by them during the quarter. The other activities held during the quarter are mentioned below :-

1. Psychosocial support to 528 people living with HIV/AIDS
2. Families provided voluntary counselling & testing services = 250
3. No. of families provided Economical and Govt Social Welfare = 106
4. Group awareness meetings held in the community on HIV = 6
5. Flu Client Tracking =366 and back to ART =142
6. No. of clients newly registered at CSC= 210
7. No. of clients found with TB/HIV = 23

1251 patients benefitted through drug-de-addiction centres of Red Cross

The Punjab Red Cross is running 4 drug-de-addiction centres at Khanpur (Mohali), Patiala, S.B.S. Nagar & Gurdaspur. 311 indoor and 940 outdoor patients were treated during the quarter and 11,143 persons were educated through 109 awareness camps. It is added here that 3 free medical check-up camps were organized. The progress of these 4 centres from July to Sept, 2019 is as under: -

RELIEF MATERIAL TO THE FLOOD VICTIMS IN DISTRICT JALANDHAR BY RED CROSS VOLUNTEERS WORKING UNDER TB PROJECT

There were havoc situation because of floods in village Gidarvindi, Darewala and Malsiyan, District Jalandhar in the last week of August 2019. The District Coordinator of TB Project and a team of 5 Red Cross volunteers visited these villages on boat and distributed food packets and other general materials to the flood victims. This material included 350 Double roti, jam & pickle, 175 roasted channa packets, 20 candle boxes, 20 agarbatti pkt (big size), 38 match boxes, 38 water bottle boxes and 800 biscuit packets etc. The said relief material was contributed by the above said Red Cross TB Project team from their own pocket.



640 PATIENTS EXAMINED IN HEALTH CHECK-UP & SCREENING CAMP AT AMRITSAR UNDER RED CROSS TB PROJECT

A large number of hidden TB cases are prevalent in the vulnerable community. These untreated patients are responsible to spread the TB infection. Therefore, in order to trace out such cases, health check up & screening camps are organized by Punjab State Red Cross Branch under the TB Project. One such camp was organized at Amritsar on 15th Sept, 2019 in collaboration with the District Health Department, Amritsar. This camp was inaugurated by Dr. Naresh Chawla, District TB Control Officer, Amritsar.



640 patients visited this camp to get their health check-up done. Out of them 207 were suffering from chest problems and 46 had symptoms of tuberculosis, 16 x-rays were done and 67 people availed the facility of sugar test etc.



A team of specialist doctors & para-medical staff and mobile medical unit was deputed by the Civil Surgeon, Amritsar in the camp. Prof. A team of two chest specialists were deputed by the Govt. Medical Col-

lege, Amritsar as a support for this camp. All the patients were also provided free medicines. The free accommodation for this camp was provided by the Sant Nirankari Mandal, Amritsar. Dr. Naresh Chawla, District TB Officer supervised the camp activities and provided all support for holding this camp.



The local cable TV channel and 3 newspapers covered the activities of this camp. One more such camp has been planned to be held at Jalandhar on 21st Oct, 2019.

Big Strides by the TB Project for Prevention & Management of Tuberculosis including MDR-TB

The Punjab State Red Cross is running a very prestigious TB Project "Prevention & Management of Tuberculosis including MDR-TB" in district Amritsar & Jalandhar. We have always achieved 100% targets in the previous 7-8 years.

Till 30th Sept, 2019, we have enrolled 418 TB patients for treatment and counselling under TB Project with the support of Red Cross Volunteers. These patients were also encouraged and motivated to include protein rich food in their daily diet so as to raise immunity level and gain weight. Secondly, body weight of each TB patient was taken every month during home visit by Red Cross Volunteers to assess the degree of improvement in health. The State Coordinator, TB also made home visit of TB patients to get direct feedback from them about their health and services being provided

by the RCVs under the project.

In order to trace out hidden TB cases in the slum areas, Indian Red Cross Society arranges number of health check-up & screening camps in the community. These camps are being organized with the support of Punjab Health Department. Since 2015, 23 such camps were organized in which 23896 patients got their health check-up done. Out of them, 9108 had chest problems while 395 patients were identified as confirmed TB cases.

The TB Project staff & volunteers conducted various group awareness meetings and mohalla meetings, went door-to-door and participated in many outreach camps held under NHM to identify the TB suspects among the vulnerable community. During the quarter, 2 nukkad Natak shows were also arranged in district Am-

ritsar to make the people aware about tuberculosis.



ALIMCO Artificial Limbs distribution Camps held

Report from District Branch, Sri Muktsar Sahib

The District Red Cross Branch, Sri Muktsar Sahib with the support of District Administration and ALIMCO India organized three artificial limbs distribution camps in July-2019 at Malout, Gidderbaha and Sri Muktsar Sahib in which 260 tricycles and 71 wheel chairs

were distributed among the needy persons. In these camps, 782 patients were examined. The District Branch provided refreshment, langer and transport facilities to & fro. The then Deputy Commissioner cum President, District Red Cross Branch, Sri Muktsar Sahib,

Dr. Sumeet Jarangal, IAS, AC(G), SDM, District Training Officer, District Education Officer and Senior Medical Officer from Gidderbaha, MOs from Lambi, Malout, Gidderbaha, school teachers & students from various schools and volunteers also attended this camp.
