NOTE:-

- 1. Against the earmarked Grant-in-Aid of Rs. 1.35 Crore (Salary) for the year 2019-20, a sum of Rs. 90,00,000/- has been received in so far. However, total expenditure incurred till date against this Grant is Rs. 1,64,89,751/-. As such, the expenditure of Rs. 74,89,751/- has been incurred in excess of the grant received. Grant under Salary Head of the staff for the months of Dec.,2019,Jan, Feb & March 2020 for a sum of Rs. 45,00,000/- is yet to be received and the expenditure for these four months of salary would be incurred of Rs 52,12,480/- (Approx.).
- 2. Necessary bill for the month of December, 2019 has already been submitted in the first week of January, 2020 to the Director, Health & Family Welfare, Punjab, for releasing this amount.
- 3. If the Salary grant amounting to Rs. 45,00,000/- of the salary for the months of December, 2019, January, February and March, 2020 is released by the Punjab Govt. even then an additional amount of Rs. 82,02,231/- will have to be spent on salary component by Punjab Red Cross Branch from its own resources.

STATUS OF GRANTS RECEIVED FROM PUNJAB GOVT.

It is submitted that we have applied for Annual Grant-in-Aid to the Director, Health & Family Welfare, Punjab for Rs. 3,00,00,000/- (Rs. Three Crore only) vide this office letter No. RC/Accounts/2019/806 dated 30 May 2019. Punjab Govt. has Sanctioned Rs. 1,35,00,000/- for the salary and Rs. 75,00,000/- for non-salary (activities of Red Cross) of first two quarters for the year 2019-20. We have not received any amount pertaining to non salary grant of Rs. 1,65,00,000/- from Govt. of Punjab upto 31.01.2020.

AGENDA ITEM No. 5

EPF SCHEME- STATUS AND LINE OF ACTION

The Regional Office of Employees Provident Fund Organization, Sector-17, Chandigarh vide their letter No. RO/CHD/C-IV intelligence-Misc./1496 dated 09.03.2017 (Annexure 'C') wrote to this office that the Central Govt. in exercise of its powers under section 16(2) of the Employees Provident Funds & Misc. Provisions Act 1952 exempted from the operation of the Act to certain establishments fulfilling terms & conditions as specified in Notification No. SO/1431 dated 14.05.2010 (Annexure 'D') upto 31.03.2015. Now the Centre Govt. has decided not to extend the grant of exemptions to these establishments and consequently, all such establishments have come under the preview of the Act w.e.f. 01.04.2015. The Employees Provident Fund Organization is requesting times and again to extend the social security benefits under the Act to all eligible employees of the Red Cross Society engaged either directly or through contractor w.e.f 01.04.2015

- 2. In an another letter No. Compliance Wing-A/1302 dated 13.03.2018 (Annexure 'E') received from EPF Office, it was mentioned that they will take "forced coverage of our establishment".
- 3. As a consequence of this the matter was considered in Finance Committee meeting held on 22.03.2018 (vide supplementary Agenda item No. 10) (Annexure 'F') and then in Managing Body meeting held on 08.06.2018 (vide Agenda item No. 6) (Annexure 'G') and it was resolved to implement the EPF Scheme in Punjab State Red Cross Branch w.e.f. 01.04.2018.
- The above decision taken in the Managing Body meeting of Punjab Red Cross Society is well in tune with the advice of Indian Red Cross Society, National Headquarters, New Delhi which was received vide their letter No G-28001/01/2018/F&A/Misc/2092 dated 30.08.2018 (Annexure 'H').
- 5. But the EPF office is continuing to insist that the EPF Scheme should be implemented from back date i.e 01.04.2015. A number of letters and notices have been issued by EPF office and

The Chairman advised that it would be better if the matter is sorted out by organizing a meeting between the higher authorities of both sides so that the wastage of precious time & efforts of both sides is avoided & the avoidable litigation is also avoided.

enquiry U/S 7-A has also been initiated.

6. If we implement the EPF Scheme from back date i.e. 01.04.2015, it may be an additional burden on the Red Cross Society of big amount to the tune of Rs. 40 lakh. This is unjustified in the light of the legal opinion as well as the advice received from the Indian Red Cross Society, National Headquarters, New Delhi. A very clear and firm opinion given by Indian Red Cross Society, National Headquarters, New Delhi is as under:-

"The Indian Red Cross Society is statutory body set up under the Indian Red Cross Society Act 1920. Being a statutory body, by virtue of Section 16(1)(C) of the Employees Provident Funds and MP Act 1952, it is specifically exempt from the applicability of the provision of the said Act.

It is also pertinent that the Indian Red Cross Society is notified under Section 8(2) of the Provident Funds Act 1925, and as such its employees are entitle to the benefits of the said Act and which benefits are being duly extended.

In view of the position explained above, you are requested to inform to the concerned authority about the status of Indian Red Cross Society regarding applicability of relevant Provident Funds Act accordingly".

7. The final decision of course always rests with the relevant Courts of jurisdiction. Since our legal experts and the Indian Red Cross Society, National Headquarters, New Delhi, have categorically stated that our case is solid and has lot of merit and also because the EPF Scheme is not applicable on our Red Cross Branch, therefore we are contesting and propose to continue to contest the case in the relevant Courts of jurisdiction, in the interest of the Red Cross Society, till the matter reaches its final logical conclusion.
