**A NEW INITIATIVE BY PUNJAB RED CROSS
First Aid Training to Members of State BAR Association**

A very historic decision to get the members of State BAR Association trained in First Aid was mutually taken by Punjab State Red Cross Branch and BAR Association Punjab & Haryana High Court. By taking a decision to impart First Aid Training to all members of the BAR Association, the Punjab State has become the first State in the country to do so. The mission and the message will reach other BAR Associations at the State levels in the entire country and at District levels in Punjab State who will emulate this fine example set by BAR Association, Punjab & Haryana High Court under the Presidentship of Sh. Dayal Partap Singh Randhawa.

In this regard, a function was held on 29th January 2020 in the auditorium of Hon'ble High court Punjab & Haryana. The glamour and glory of the function was further increased with the presence of two Hon'ble Judges of Punjab & Haryana High Court namely; Hon'ble Justice Rajeev Sharma who was the Chief Guest and Justice H. S. Sidhu who attended the function as its Guest of Honor. Another feather in the cap was the presence of Hon'ble Speaker of Haryana Vidhan Sabha, Sh. Gian Chand Gupta Ji, who declared on the spot that he would get the entire staff of Haryana Vidhan Sabha also trained in First Aid Training. Sh. ORGANIZATION OF NATIONAL YOUTH EXCHANGE PROGRAMME: 7 DAY CAMP



National Youth Exchange Program was organized by Punjab State Red Cross Branch with the main objective of promoting Health Service, inculcating the spirit of National Integration and involving the youth in cleanliness campaign. The 7 days camp was organized at Bhavan's SL Public School, Amritsar from 27th Dec 2019 to 3rd Jan 2020. The Hon'ble Governor of Punjab and President, Punjab State Red Cross Branch, Sh. V. P. Singh Badnore sent his blessings for successful organization of this camp.



As many as 300 students including counselors from 11 States and 11 Districts of Punjab participated in the camp. The inaugural ceremony of the week long camp was held on 28th Dec 2019. S. Shivdular Singh Dhillon, IAS, Deputy Commissioner cum President, District Red Cross Branch, Amritsar was the Chief Guest. Rich tributes were paid to Sir Jean Henry Dunant, Bhai Ghanaiya Ji and Swami Vivekananda Ji by the Chief Guest.

The valedictory function in this regard was held on 3rd Jan 2020 which was attended by Sh. Avinash Rai Khanna, National Vice Chairman of IRCS, NHQs as Chief Guest who graced the occasion.

The Programme was marked by contests and competitions of written quiz, cultural dance, folk dance, group dance, patriotic folk song competition & group songs, declamation contest, paper reading contest & poster making competition on Save Water and Save the Girl Child etc.



Through these competitions and cultural activities, the youth volunteers were encouraged to fight against the peer pressure and create awareness on various social issues. Free food & lodging facilities were provided to all the delegates during this camp. Daily yoga training was also a chapter of the camp. The volunteers were apprised about fit India, and Healthy India campaign of Prime Minister of India. During the camp, the volunteers were taken to the Golden Temple, Jalianwala Bagh and Wagha Border to apprise them about the moments of the history. A day of the camp was dedicated to Swacchh Bharat Abhiyan in which the volunteers were taken to the nearest villages of Amritsar for Swachhata Abhiyan.

In the light of said decision, Punjab State Red Cross Branch of the Indian Red Cross Society celebrated the day in a befitting manner on 29.01.2020. A very significant and colorful function was organized in Chandigarh University, Gharuan in which 15 teams from 14 districts of Punjab State participated in the Quiz contest and Poster making competition.

Punjab Red Cross at the Service of Pilgrims of Maghi Mela at Sri Muktsar Sahib and Holla Mohalla at Sri Anandpur Sahib



Maghi is the occasion when the Sikhs commemorate the sacrifice of forty Sikhs, who fought for Guru Gobind Singh Ji. Maghi, Makara Sankranti, the first day of the month of Magh. For Sikh community, Maghi means primarily the festival at Muktsar, a district town of the Punjab, in commemoration of the heroic fight of the Chali Mukte, literally, the Forty Liberated Ones, who laid down their lives warding off an attack by an imperial army marching in pursuit of Guru Gobind Singh Ji on December 29, 1705 near a pool of water, Khidrane di Dhab. The bodies were cremated on the following day. The first of Magh (name of the festival), now falls usually on 13th of January.

On the eve of Maghi, huge number of pilgrims assemble and take a holy dip in the holy waters of 'Sarovar'. They also pay their obeisance by visiting different shrines.

ROLE OF RED CROSS

In an another important meeting of Secretaries of District Red Cross Branches held

during the year 2018 under the Chairmanship of Shri C. S. Talwar, IAS (Retd.), Secretary, Punjab State Red Cross Branch, it was decided that the State Branch in collaboration with all the District Red Cross Branches will provide services to the visiting pilgrims during the period of the Melas, by setting up of First Aid Posts in collaboration with District Administration, Health Department and District Red Cross Branches in their respective areas, where such melas are organized.

RED CROSS AT SERVICE OF PILGRIMS

In order to provide services to the visiting pilgrims, Punjab State Red Cross Branch in collaboration with District Administration, District Health Department and District Red Cross Branch, Sri Muktsar Sahib, Fazilka & Ferozepur organized Social Service Camp by the way of establishing First Aid Posts in the Mela area and also deputed Ambulance vans to transport the injured and sick quickly to the nearest health centres. Various District Branches like - Sri Muktsar Sahib, Fazilka & Ferozepur. On these posts, Red Cross staff alongwith a team of 32 Red Cross volunteers provided day & night services to the visiting pilgrims. The medicines were provided by State as well as District Red Cross Branches free of cost. Thousands of pilgrims were examined and provided medicines at these First Aid Posts and many were taken to hospital for emergency treatment during

the mela period from 13th to 14th January, 2020.

Three(3) Day Social Service Camp at Holla Mohalla from 8th to 10th March 2020

On the eve of Holla Mohalla generally held in the month of March, lakhs of pilgrims assemble at Sri Anandpur Sahib (Punjab). In order to provide services to the visiting pilgrimages, Punjab State Red Cross Branch in collaboration with District Administration, District Health Department and District Red Cross Branches of Amritsar, Faridkot, Hoshiarpur, Jalandhar, Kapurthala, Ludhiana, Mohali, Patiala, Ropar & Taran Tarn organized a three day social service camp by setting up of 18 First Aid Posts in the mela area. On these posts, Red Cross staff alongwith team of 200 Red Cross volunteers provided day night services to the visiting pilgrimages. Punjab State Red Cross provided medicines free of cost to the pilgrims, who came to First Aid Posts set up by the Red Cross for seeking help. As many as 87,050 persons were examined and provided medicines free of cost during the period of the Holla Mohalla from 8th to 10th March, 2020 at these First Aid Posts. Besides this 21 injured persons were transported to the local Hospital and 12 lost children were helped to reunite with their par-

Care & support to HIV patients

A care & support centre is working at Saket Hospital, Patiala by the Punjab State Red Cross Branch, Chandigarh for the patients living with HIV/AIDS. This project is being sponsored by Hindustan Latex Family Planning Promotion Trust, Noida. Sarbat Da Bhala, charitable Trust is providing their assistance in holding monthly camps for PLHIV. The activities held under the project are as under :-

1. Psychosocial support to people living with HIV/AIDS
2. Families provided voluntary counselling & testing services
3. No. of families provided Economical and Govt Social Welfare
4. Group awareness meetings held in the community on HIV
5. Flu Clients are tacked and put back to ART
6. New clients are registered at CSC.

539 TB patients provided care & support, health education and counselling by Punjab Red Cross

The TB Project is being implemented successfully by Punjab State Red Cross Branch in district Amritsar and Jalandhar since 2009, with the support by Indian Red Cross Society, National Headquarters and Irish Red Cross Society. Under this Project we have been providing treatment to the poor, illiterate and vulnerable TB Patients living in slum areas through Red Cross & the Project volunteers. The State Branch has been achieving more than 100% targets since many years. Due to the outstanding performance, the Punjab State has been declared as the "Best Performing State" in the report of National Headquarters and sanctioned a prestigious TB Project for Punjab only in the year 2015. Under this project, the services are being provided through 15-20 Red Cross volunteers.

Punjab Red Cross is providing support in treatment of 400 TB patients every year. So far Punjab State Red Cross Branch has helped in treatment of 2500 TB patients by providing counselling, nutrition care and nutrition education etc.

This is pertinent to mention here that from Aug-2019 to 31st March-2020, we have enrolled 539 TB patients for treatment through volunteers which is 135% of the target fixed by the IRCS, NHQs. The Red Cross volunteers are provided light weight portable weighing machines through which they took the weight of each TB patient during their home visits in order to monitor their health status and

gain of body weight.

Earlier till May 2019, we were providing small nutrition care in kind (egg, milk, chana, nutri, bread etc to the patients who were enrolled under this project along-with other services i.e. counseling and education to TB patients and their families. But this activity has been stopped as per directions of the National Headquarters because the Health Department is giving Rs.500/- to each TB patients under DBT Scheme (Direct Benefit Transfer).

To create awareness by conducting group meetings, mohalla meetings, arranging nukkad natak etc to spread the correct information on TB to the masses especially in the vulnerable community is an important activity of the project.



Punjab Red Cross launched SOCIAL EMERGENCY RESPONSE VOLUNTEERS (SERV) Scheme

The SOCIAL EMERGENCY RESPONSE VOLUNTEERS (SERV) Scheme has been launched in two Districts of Punjab namely; Gurdaspur and Fazilka as well as at State Headquarters. In this regard, the Punjab State Red Cross Branch organized a camp from 12th to 14th March-2020 at Punjab Red Cross Bhawan, Chandigarh in which 40 volunteers were trained. Similarly, 40 volunteers in each district were also trained.



18 Instructors trained under SERV Scheme

Punjab Red Cross conducted a 7 days camp for Instructors training under SERV Scheme. 22 persons participated in the camp, out of them 18 qualified as Instructors. An inspection team consisting of three members from New Delhi interacted with participants and examined their skills. These qualified instructors will further impart training to the volunteers registered under SERV Scheme in the Districts.



Punjab Red Cross organized one week camp to create more Lay Lecturers in First Aid

In order to train more lay Lecturers, Punjab State Red Cross Branch and St. John Ambulance Association of Punjab State Centre organized a five day camp for First Aid Lecturers' Training from 12th to 16th March 2020. 20 persons participated in this camp. Some participants were qualified as full-fledged Lecturers after attending this training successfully, some of them were there for renewal of their Lecturers' license and others improved upon previous qualifications.



PUNJAB RED CROSS LAUNCHED AWARENESS CAMPAIGN ON CORONA VIRUS

As desired by the Hon'ble Governor of Punjab – cum-President, Punjab Red Cross, the State Branch has launched a vigorous campaign regarding spreading awareness about deadly Corona Virus. The message of Hon'ble Governor was conveyed to all the Deputy Commissioners-cum-President, District Red Cross Branches and Societies. The campaign was started by all the District Red Cross Societies and Project Directors and Coordinators of Punjab State Red Cross Branch accordingly.

Some special features of the campaign at District level are as under: -

- Awareness in schools
- Involvement of local NGOs, Child Development and Protection Officer etc.
- Involvement of Panchayat Officers to aware all the Sarpanches through DDPOs and BDPOs.
- Publicity through Pamphlets / Flex banners / social media etc.

Like District Branches, the State Red Cross Branch has also started its activities regarding awareness on COVID19. Nukkar Nataks on Corona Virus was staged on 09.03.2020 near Rose Garden, Sector 16, Chandigarh which was attended by about 150 persons including First Aid trainees, PRC staff members, staff of Haryana Red Cross and State Information Commission office etc. Pamphlets were distributed to the people visiting Red Cross Bhawan either Red Cross office or office of State Information Commission.



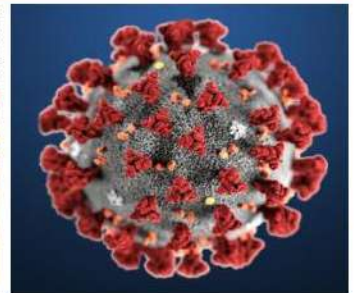
First Aid trainees and Patient Care Attendants and students of Computer Training Centres at Chandigarh & Patiala were educated on COVID-19 through lectures and Powerpoint presentations. Flex Banners with messages on Corona virus were displayed at important places like entrance of Red Cross Bhawan, near rose garden, bus stand etc.

It is worth to mention here that the TB patients enrolled under our TB Project were specially cautioned about Corona Virus because they have low immunity system and may catch the disease easily. They were provided special education and awareness about COVID-19. Some needy patients were provided dry ration kits by the Red Cross volunteers out of their own contribution during lockdown period.

In regard, District Red Cross Branches also came forward to help the needy in lockdown from 24th March, 2020 onwards. Red Cross ambulances of the District Branches are placed at the disposal of District Administration to transport the needy/sick people. Free food packets and dry ration kits were distributed to needy section through Red Cross volunteers by the District Red Cross Branches.

कोरोना की अत्याधुनिक कई संस्थाएं आने आकर जन कल्याण में जुटी हुई हैं। जहाँ रेडक्रॉस की इस कदम में पीछे नहीं है। रेडक्रॉस सोसायटी के सचिव नरेश गुप्ता ने बताया कि रेडक्रॉस इन दिनों जो मरीज क्वारंटाइन किए गए हैं या फिर जो पॉजिटिव पाए गए हैं उन्हें अपने बतर पर पीछे अहार उपलब्ध करवा रही हैं। अपनी तक यह बात सामने आई है कि कोरोना से केवल नहीं मरीज स्वस्थ हो रहे हैं लिनक इन्फेक्शन अच्छे हैं और

अच्छी इन्फेक्शन के लिए पीछे अहार की जरूरत बहुत अधिक है। इन मरीजों के लिए तीन टाइम का खाना जोकि पूरे तरह से पीछे हो रेडक्रॉस मुहैया करवा रही है। इसका अलावा मरीजों को क्वारंटाइन भी उपलब्ध कराया जा रहा है। यहाँ रेडक्रॉस की मदद के लिए कुछ समाज सेवक भी आगे आ रहे हैं और एक ऑफिस के डिवाइस से अब तक जिला में रेडक्रॉस को यह समाज सेवक लगभग 40 लाख रुपये अनुदान दे चुके हैं जिससे रेडक्रॉस खरी दंग से काम चला रही है।
