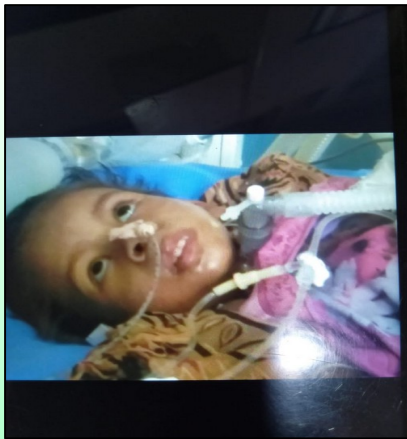

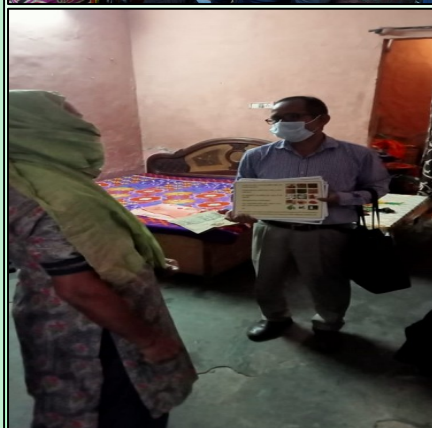
First Aid Training by Punjab Red Cross
