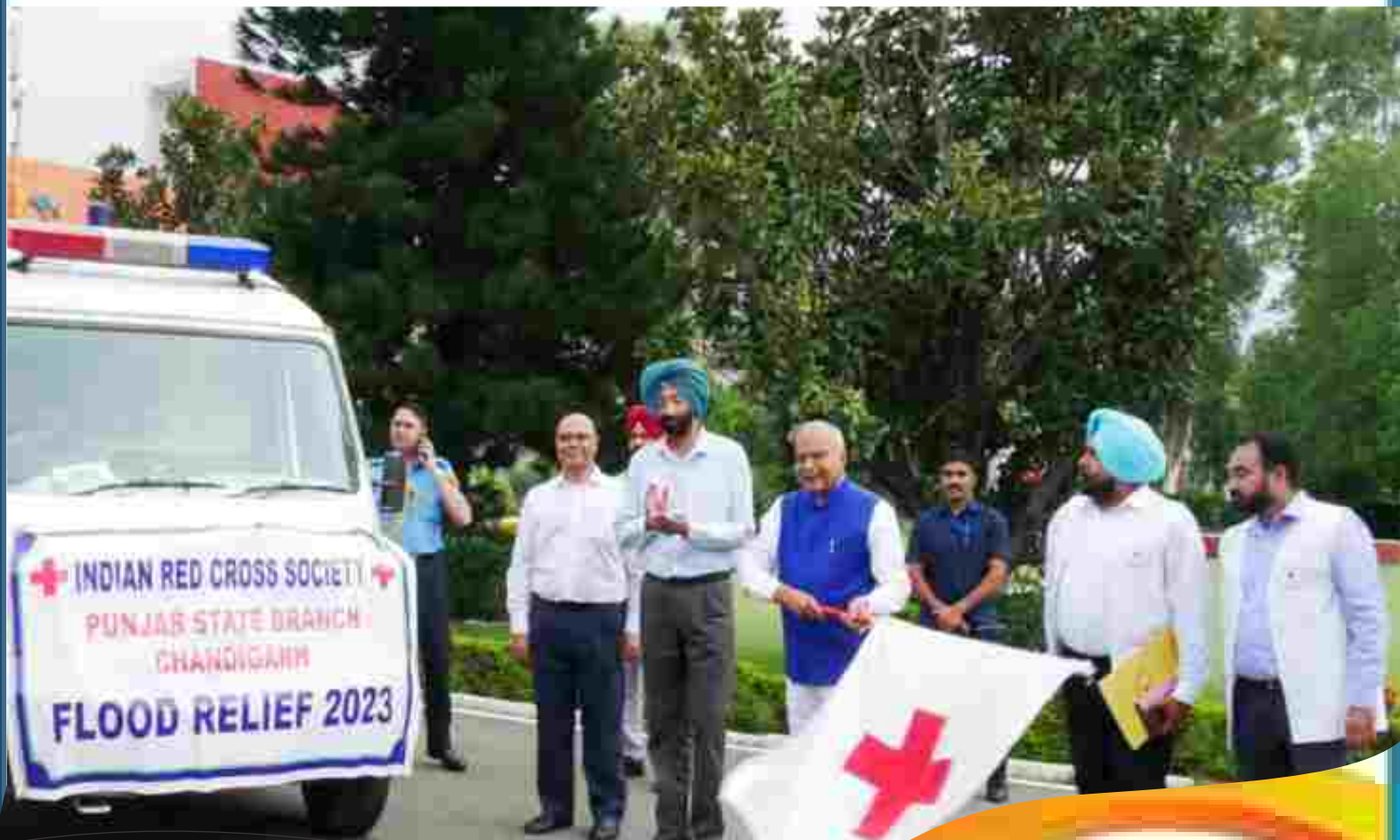

Punjab State Red Cross Disburses Flood Relief Material of About 50 lakh to the 14 Flood Affected Districts of Punjab.

Hon'ble Governor Punjab Cum President Punjab State Red Cross Flagged Off Relief Material

As devastating floods hit many districts of Punjab, Punjab State Red Cross arose to the occasion, and even as the first reports of the havoc unleashed by the floods trickled in, the Red Cross teams immediately swung into action.

Under the visionary leadership of the Hon'ble Governor, cum President of Punjab State Red Cross Shri Banwarilal Purohit Ji, the State Red Cross giving evidence of foresight and advance planning had prepositioned critical flood relief material which was dispatched to the affected areas immediately with unparalleled efficiency and swiftness beginning from day one of the floods. This most timely providing of relief material to the district Red Cross Branches which further ensured door step delivery to the marooned people, saw flood relief measures being carried out at their efficacious best.

Forthwith dispatch of tents and tarpaulins etc enable the setting up of relief camps right at the outset itself, thereby providing succour to the people rendered hominess by the floods. Convoys of relief floods material to the affected districts were flagged off by the Hon'ble Governor or himself. This gesture of our President went a long way in boosting the morale of entire disaster response team, who tirelessly worked to ameliorate the suffering of the people in the flood ravaged areas. The Punjab State Branch created a new record of sending about 50 lacs worth of relief material to 14 districts in the State.

Ration Kits Distributed to TB Patients

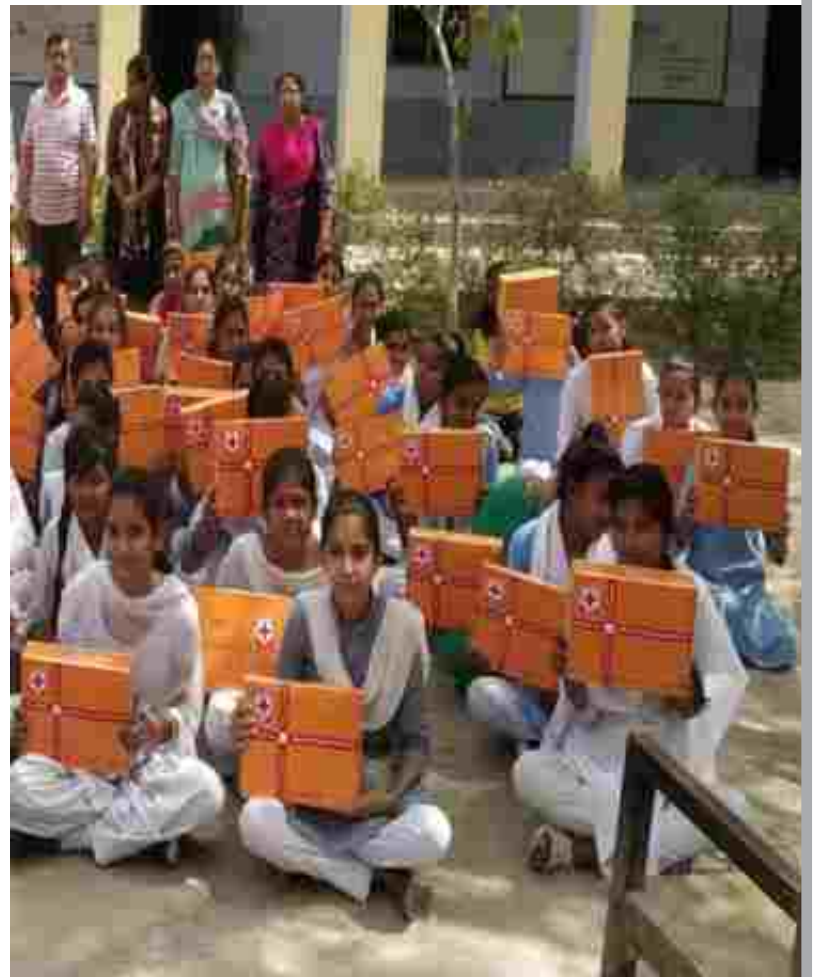
